Contributions to American Agency System - includes participation/involvement in either/both the Field Representative’s club and Agents’ Association affairs (points are awarded for committee work, membership and convention participation, and honors/awards.)

Community Affairs - civic, charitable and church service

Performance as an Industry Spokesperson.

The nominee with the highest point total is chosen. Agents are particularly encouraged to submit nominations.

PIA and the Awards Committee reserve the right to determine qualified candidates from nominations received. Information packets for judging will only be sent to qualified candidates. Further, the Awards Committee retains the decision as to whether an award is given.
